4.1-1. Registered email address

PART 4: MISCELLANEOUS

4.1-1. Registered email address

- (1) This rule applies to the registered email address as set out in an application for incorporation or notification given to the Registrar of Companies, under the AIFC General Partnership Regulations.
- (2) The registered email address must at all times be an appropriate email address.
- (3) An email address is an “appropriate email address” if, in the ordinary course of events, emails sent to it by the Registrar would be expected to come to the attention of a Person acting on behalf of the General Partnership or Recognised Partnership.
- (4) The notification of change of a partnership’s registered email address must include a statement that the new email address is an appropriate email address within the meaning given by subrule (3).

4.2. Public registers of partnerships

4.2.1. The Registrar of Companies must, in the relevant register kept by the Registrar under section 59 (Public registers of partnerships) of the AIFC General Partnership Regulations, record the following details, so far as relevant, in relation to each General Partnership or Recognised Partnership that is, or has been, registered in the AIFC:
